3-Day Portrait Painting Workshop

3-day portrait painting workshop taught by artist Lori Anne Harris focusing on building a stronger foundation in traditional portraiture. Students will work from the Principles of facial feature placement to create a convincing, lifelike portrait in acrylic. This workshop is open to artists with painting experience interested in improving their ability in acrylic painting.

Students will create a portrait over the duration of the workshop. Technical instruction will be supplemented with brief lectures and demonstrations to learn Lori Anne's painting process. Lori Anne will also assist students individually during the workshop.

Artists, ranging from beginning to advanced, will have the opportunity to receive one-on-one instruction gaining a fuller knowledge of traditional portraiture. This class is definitely not for the casual hobbyist but for the serious artist who wants to take his/her art career to the next level.

Class Description:

Students will work to create a convincing, lifelike portrait. The workshop will cover key concepts including planes of the head, proportion and placement of features of the face, light & shadow, shapes, values & edges, color mixing/theory, use of acrylic painting medium, brush control, studio practices and proper use of materials.

Who:

Classes are open to artists, ranging from beginning to advanced, interested in taking his/her art career to the next level. The size of the group will be limited to 10 to optimize the learning experience so book fast.
